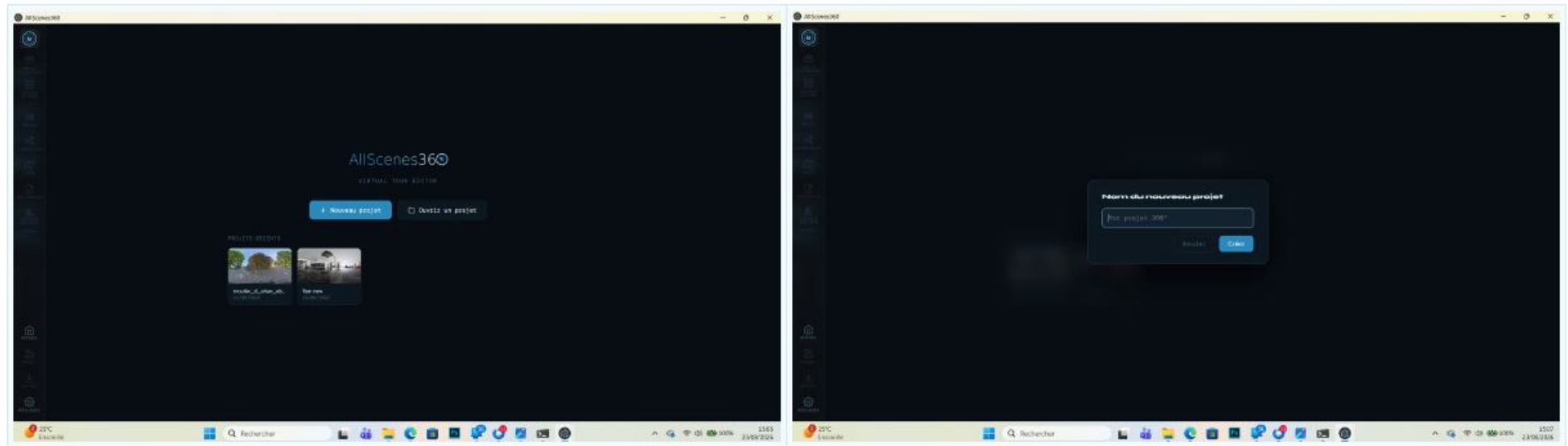
Premiers pas avec AllScenes360

01 - Create a project and import media

Getting started with AllScenes360

Create a project and import media

Objective. Create a project, discover the media dashboard, import panoramas and open the 360° editor.



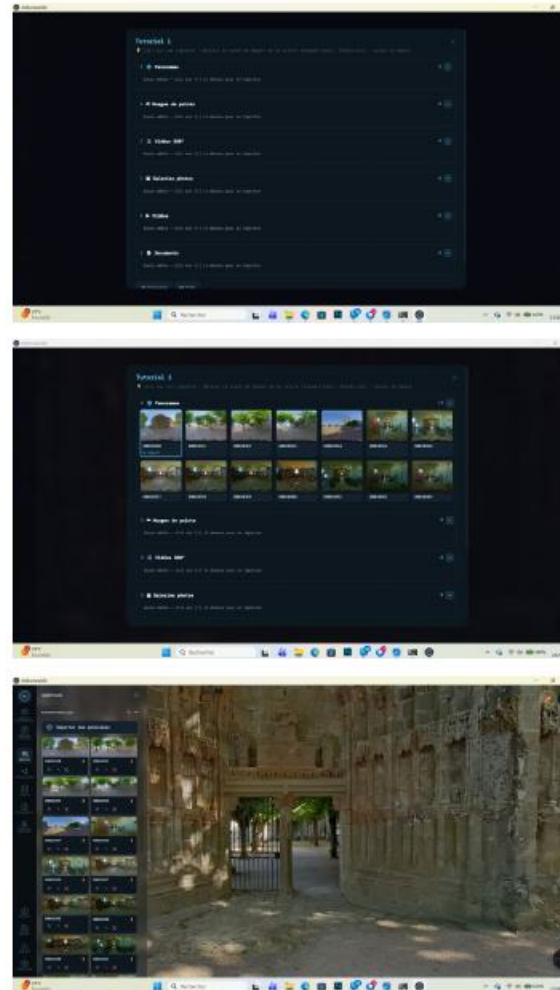
- 01 On the home page, click « Nouveau projet ».
- 02 Enter a clear project title, then click « Créer ».
- 03 The dashboard organizes panoramas, point clouds, 360° videos, photo galleries, videos and documents.

Create a project and import media - Procedure

- 04 Use the + button in « Panoramas » and select your files.
- 05 Check the imported thumbnails, then click « Ouvrir l'éditeur 360° ».
- 06 In the Media panel, the red cross deletes a panorama. The confirmation step allows you to cancel.

Key point

Other media types are imported from their respective sections and remain available in the corresponding editor panels.





TUTORIEL 2

Relier deux panoramas

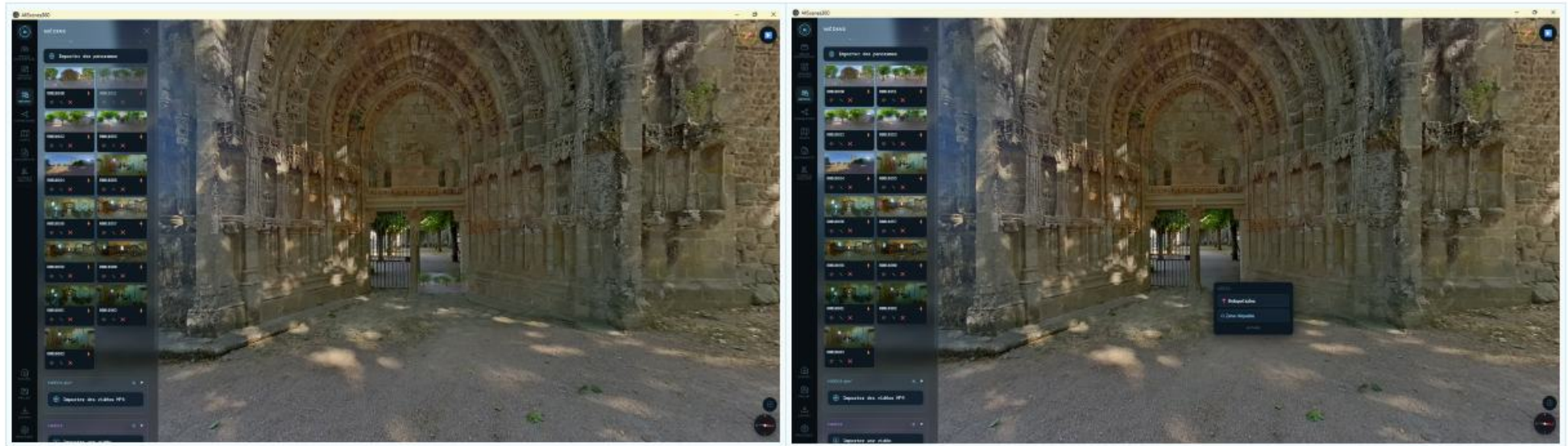
Créer des hotspots de navigation

02 - Connect two panoramas

Create navigation hotspots

Connect two panoramas

Objective. Create two-way navigation between two panoramas and test it in visit mode.



- 01 Drag the destination panorama from the Media panel into the current scene.
- 02 Choose « Hotspot icône » or « Zone cliquable ». Select « Hotspot icône » here.
- 03 Move or resize the window if it hides an important area.
- 04 Browse suggested, animated, fixed, favorite and recent icon tabs.

Connect two panoramas - Procedure

- 05 Choose an icon and place it accurately in the starting panorama.
- 06 Place the return hotspot in the destination panorama.
- 07 Orient the arrival view and use « Capturer » to save it.
- 08 Switch between edit mode and visit mode to test both directions.

Key point

A bidirectional connection provides natural navigation because each panorama includes a hotspot to the other.





TUTORIEL 3

Ajouter des points d'intérêt interactifs

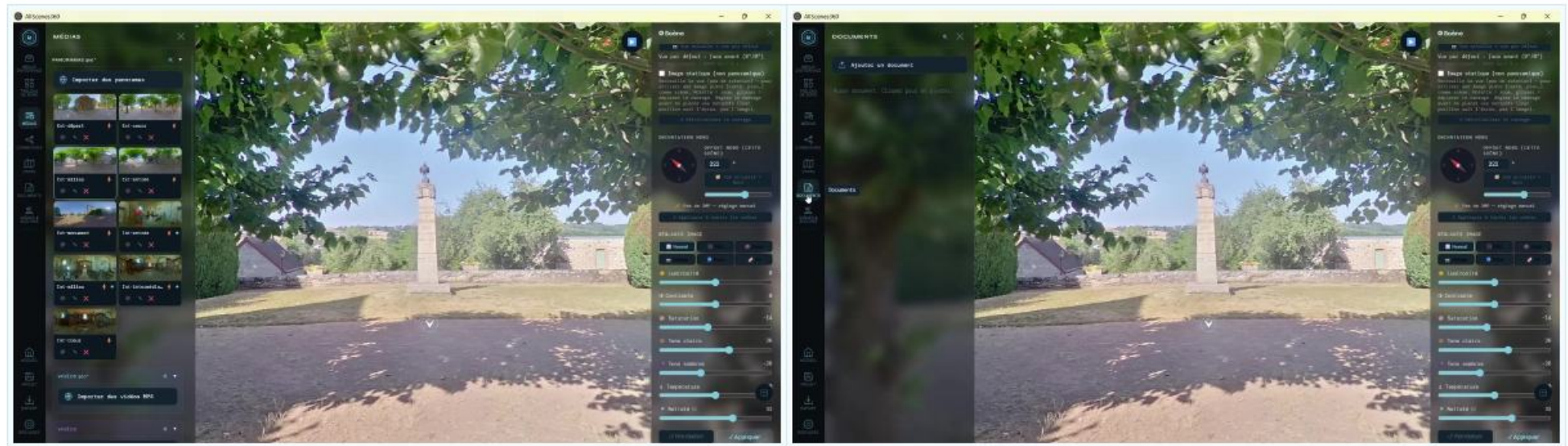
Médias, documents et liens web

03 - Add interactive points of interest

Media, documents and web links

Add interactive points of interest

Objective. Enrich a scene with additional content opened from a hotspot.



- 01 Open « Icônes & Add-ons », place an icon and select its type in the Hotspot panel.
- 02 The Media category includes panoramas, photo galleries, videos, 360° videos and point clouds.
- 03 For media content, drag the item from the library onto the hotspot.

Add interactive points of interest - Procedure

- 04 Documents work in the same way: import the file, then drag and drop it.
- 05 For a web link, select « Lien web », enter the complete address and confirm.
- 06 Use visit mode and open every hotspot to verify the media, document and web page.

Key point

Drag and drop is the main interaction. Use short titles and optimized media for smooth viewing.



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TUTORIEL 4

Configurer les cartes et la minimap

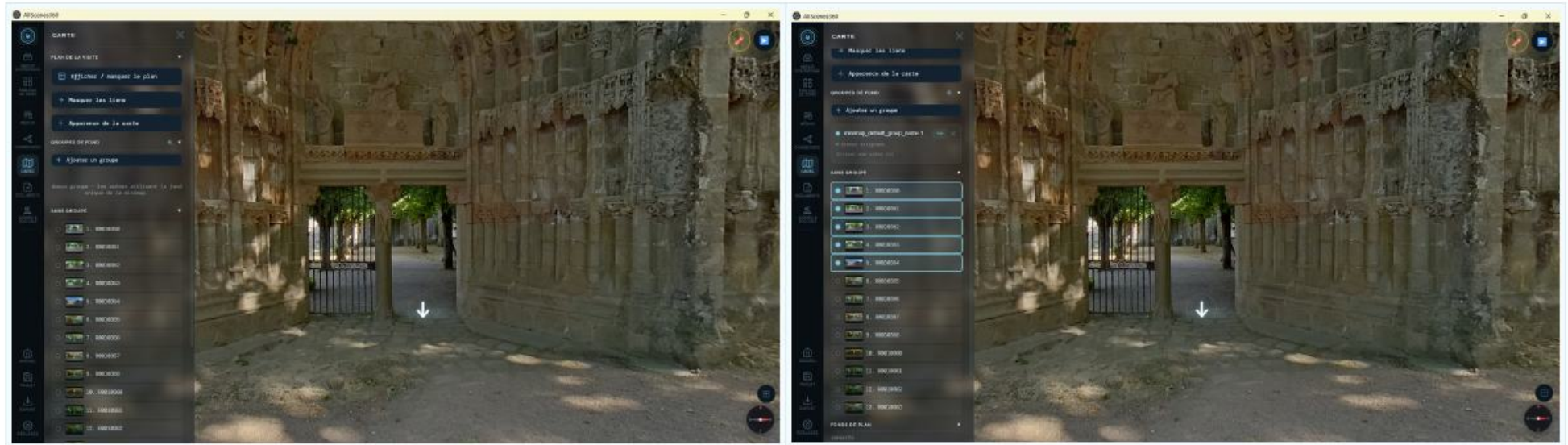
Organiser les scènes et orienter le plan

04 - Configure maps and the minimap

Organize scenes and orient the plan

Configure maps and the minimap

Objective. Group panoramas by map background, configure the minimap and align positions, view radars and north.



- 01 Open « Carte » and add a background group.
- 02 Select the relevant scenes and drag them into the group.
- 03 Rename the group, for example « Extérieur », and assign a background image.
- 04 Create the « Intérieur » group in the same way and assign its floor plan.

Configure maps and the minimap - Procedure

- 05 Open the minimap, enlarge it and use zoom controls as needed.
- 06 Switch to map edit mode and reposition every capture point.
- 07 Display panorama links to check the consistency of the route.
- 08 Set north, then orient the viewing radar for each panorama.

Key point

In visit mode, points match panoramas, viewing angles are correctly oriented and the compass uses the north setting.



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TUTORIEL 5

Visualiser et compléter les connexions

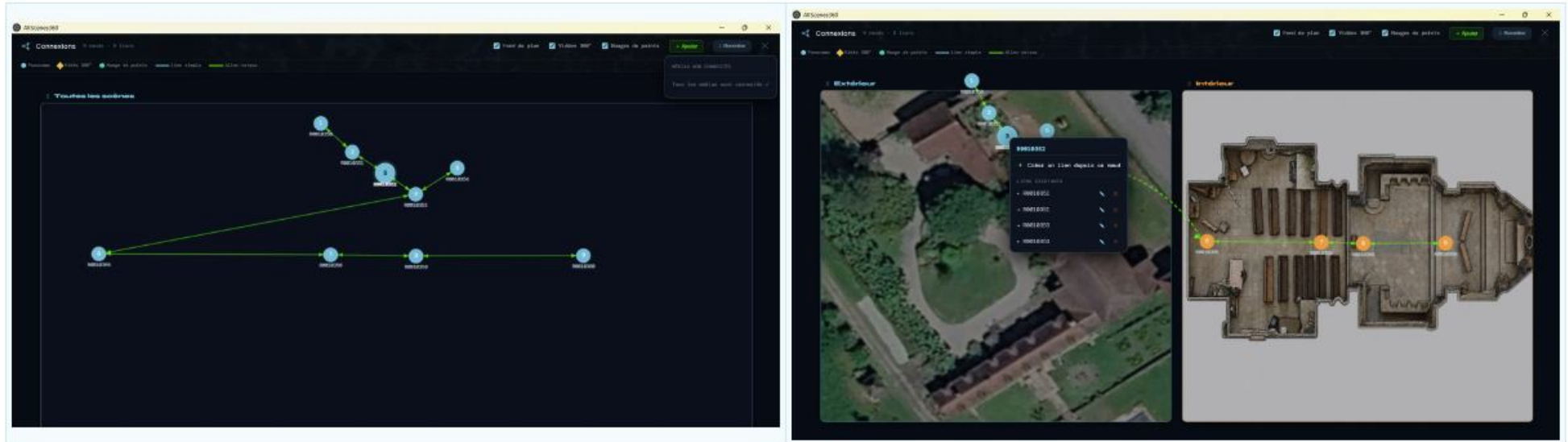
Contrôler les liens entre les panoramas

05 - View and complete connections

Check links between panoramas

View and complete connections

Objective. Review the complete navigation network and quickly create a missing two-way link.



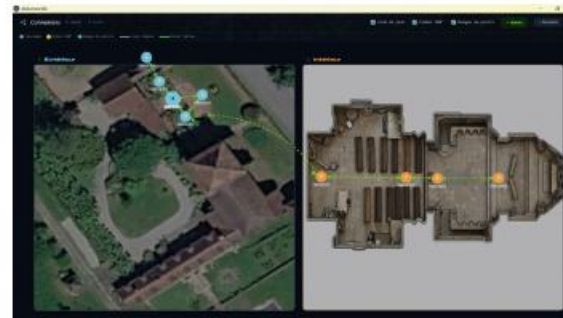
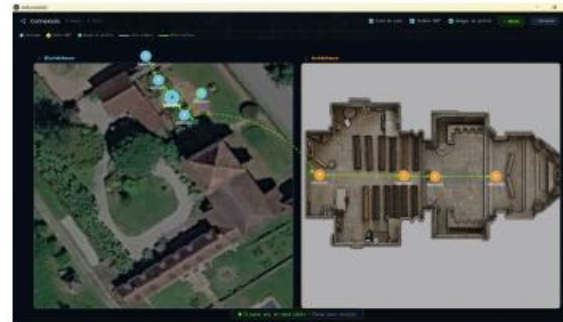
- 01 Open « Connexions » from the left rail.
- 02 Show or hide map backgrounds to switch between a schematic and contextual view.
- 03 Identify one-way and two-way links at a glance. In the example, the connection between points 3 and 5 is missing.

View and complete connections - Procedure

- 04 Click point 3, then choose « Créer un lien depuis ce nœud ».
- 05 Click point 5 to set the target.
- 06 Choose navigation icons in the dialog and place them in both panoramas.
- 07 Click « Terminer »: the two-way connection appears in the global view.

Key point

The Connections view complements the 360° editor by revealing omissions and simplifying structural corrections.





TUTORIEL 6

Sauvegarder et reprendre un projet

Protéger et retrouver son travail

06 - Save and resume a project

Protect and retrieve your work

Save and resume a project



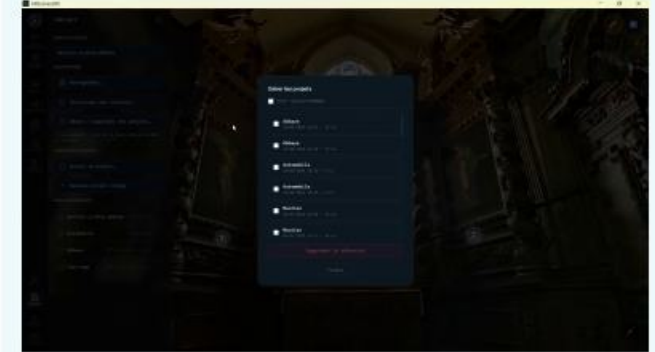
1 Save manually

In Project, check the name and click "Sauvegarder". Choose a folder and save the AS360 file.



2 Retrieve a version

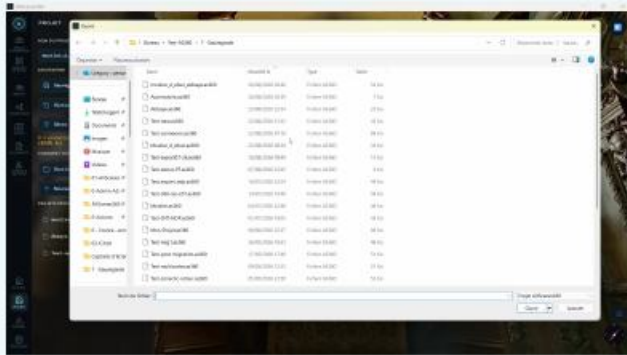
The history lists backups by date and time. Automatic versions are marked "auto" and can be restored.



3 Manage old projects

Select projects you no longer need, then use "Supprimer la sélection". The currently open project remains protected.

Protect and retrieve your work



4 Open a project

Click "Ouvrir un projet", select the AS360 file in Windows, then confirm with "Ouvrir".



5 Start a new project

"Nouveau projet vierge" leaves the current project and returns you to the starting point.



6 Configure automatic backup

In Réglages > Sauvegarde, choose the number of retained versions, enable automatic backup and set its interval.



TUTORIEL 7

Exporter une visite virtuelle

07 - Export a virtual tour

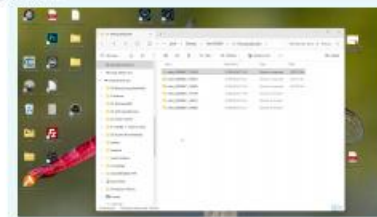
Prepare the export

- 1 Open "Export" in the left sidebar.
- 2 Set compression for panoramas, photos and 360° videos.
- 3 Choose the target: Windows, Mac/Linux, Universal, Web or SCORM.
- 4 Select the destination folder with "Browse".
- 5 Open advanced settings to customize the export.
- 6 With Studio, customize the interface and White Label options.



Generate and launch the tour

- 7 Configure the General, Tour, Media and Point Clouds sections.
- 8 Return to Export and click "Export as ZIP".
- 9 Extract the generated archive in the destination folder.
- 10 Launch the Tour application or use the HTML version.
- 11 For online publishing, upload the Web or Universal version to a compatible server.



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Remember: the ZIP can be archived, copied or shared. The next tutorial will focus on point clouds.
